English as an Alternative Language (EAL) Courses

Duke Street Community House is a Registered Training Organisation (3779) and we offer the following accredited courses:-

Course in EAL (22259VIC)

Certificate I in EAL (22250VIC)

Certificate II in EAL (22251VIC)

Students interested in enrolling in these courses will be required to participate in an assessment interview to ensure they are placed in an appropriate level.

Days and times depend on the level but all classes are held Monday to Thursday.

Cost: \$50 per term for eligible students.

EAL Pre-Literacy

This Pre-Literacy EAL is for non-English speakers with little or no knowledge of language literacy. Preliminary to first accredited English course.

Computer Courses

EAL Digital Literacy (levels 0–3) Pre-accredited Computer skills

These classes are available to all students who are enrolled in an Accredited English as an alternative language course at Duke Street Community House. The course is designed to enhance computer skills through English language study.

Class days & times depend on the student's skill level but all classes are held Monday - Thursday.
